

The Boettcher Scholar Alumni Board is a vital and valued extension of the Boettcher Foundation. As such, Foundation staff, Trustee representation, and Boettcher Scholar Alumni Board members work closely together to deliver high-quality programming and engagement for current and Alumni Scholars. The Boettcher Scholar Alumni Board is formally recognized and supported by the Boettcher Foundation.

Boettcher Scholar Alumni Board Responsibilities:

- Work together with Boettcher staff on advancing the Foundation's strategy and carrying out the board's mission,
- Plan and lead long-standing education, service, and networking events,
- Provide support for Alumni communication efforts, ongoing integrated programming, and other special initiatives and pilots as designed by the Foundation,
- Serve as responsible stewards of the budget entrusted to the board by the Foundation,
- Ensure the long-term sustainability of the board by recruiting, orienting, and supporting board members over the life of their terms,
- Serve as trusted representatives of the Foundation.

Prospective members can be nominated or apply to the group by emailing Floyd Pierce at floyd@boettcherfoundation.org. Prospective members must submit a letter of interest containing their reasons for wanting to join the board and their expected level of commitment. These letters/nominations will be reviewed first by a nominations committee established by the board and then by the Boettcher Scholar Alumni Board's Executive Committee. Materials will be reviewed through the lenses of current board composition, diversity goals, and skills needed. The board aims to have a maximum of 19 members at any time, with a minimum of 12 members.

However, **even if there are no open board positions, the board is always looking for volunteers to serve on their committees.** The committees are as follows:

- Outreach Committee – Responsible for communicating with the Alumni base and developing community partnerships.
- Programming Committee – Responsible for creating Alumni events that build engagement and connection within the Scholar community.
- Special Event and Initiatives Ad Hoc Committee – Supports Foundation special initiatives and programs.
